Your Badge:

Badges are required for entry into all meetings, session and events, especially at Hotels and BC Place Stadium. If you haven't received your badge in the mail, please proceed to Hall A East.

Your Passport (and other documents):

If you are travelling from outside of Canada, make sure your passport is packed so you can celebrate your sobriety. To be extra cautious, print out your hotel and flight information and have it on your person when travelling.

A Mobile Device:

Make sure to download the Convention Mobile App by searching "A.A.W.S. Events" in your mobile device's app store. Selected sessions will offer simultaneous translation and assistive listening support through Wordly, for which we strongly suggest you bring their own wired earbuds or headphones. Pack a portable charger so you can stay connected!
